

12. Verbs. 1

Verbs add an *s*.

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In third person singular and nowhere else.

I come, you come, he/she comes.

I know, you know, he/she knows.

I sing, you sing, he/she sings.

I listen, you listen, he and she listens.

After a hissing sound.

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An *s* isn't enough.

Then you add *-es* to clear things up.

I wish, you wish, he/she wishes.

I teach, you teach, he/she teaches.

I kiss, you kiss, he/she kisses.

I mix, you mix, he and she mixes.
