

13. Verbs. 2

Verbs that end in a consonant
plus the letter *y*,
they change *y* to *i* and add *-es*.
In third person singular and nowhere else.

I cry, you cry, he/she cries.
I try, you try, he/she tries.
I fly, you fly, he/she flies.
I hurry, you hurry, he and she hurries.

Some verbs add and change
nothing at all.
Learn the verbs
and they shall not disturb.

I can, you can, he/she can.
I may, you may, he/she may.
I must, you must, he/she must.
I will, you will, he and she will.

I shall, you shall, he/she shall - meet again.
See you later my friend.
