

17. The personal pronouns

The personal pronouns are:

I, you, he, she, we, you and they.

Like when you say:

I´ve got a jacket.

You´ve got a racket.

He´s got a shirt.

She´s got a skirt.

We´ve got a scooter.

You´ve got a computer.

They´ve got a CD, a TV and a DVD.

(Voice: The pronoun is the subject. *Have got* is the verb. The noun is the object).

The personal pronouns can also be:

Me, you, him, her, us, you and them.

Like when you say:

The jacket belongs to me.

The racket belongs to you.

The shirt belongs to him.

The skirt belongs to her.

The scooter belongs to us.

The PC belongs to you.

The CD, the TV and the DVD belong to them.

(Voice: The noun is the subject. *To belong* is the verb. The pronoun is the object).
