

18. The possessive pronouns

The possessive pronouns are:

Mine, yours, his, hers, ours, yours and theirs.

Like when you say:

The job is mine.

The shop is yours.

The hat is his.

The cat is hers.

The honey is ours.

The money is yours.

The CD, the TV and the DVD are theirs.

(Voice: The noun is the subject. *To be* is the verb. The possessive pronoun is the complement).

The possessive pronouns can also be:

My, your, his, her, our, your and their.

Like when you say:

It's my job.

It's your shop.

It's his hat.

It's her cat.

It's our honey.

It's your money.

It's their CD, their TV and their DVD.

(Voice: *It* is the subject. *To be* is the verb. The possessive pronoun is the object).
